JOB TITLE	River Watcher and Guide (Seasonal)
REPORTING TO	Estate Manager
DEPARTMENT/S(DIVISION)	The Barroncom Estate on occasion but predominantly the Aberscorn Fishery where it extends along the Rivers Mourne, Strule and Derg.
START DATE	1 st April 2023 (possible earlier)
MAIN PURPOSE	To assist with the management of the Aberscorn Fishery on the Rivers Mourne, Derg and Strule.
DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (NOT EXHAUSTIVE)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maintenance of the fishery's facilities and ensuring all associated infrastructure is kept in a high and safe state of repair• Feeding guests• Liaising with the Estate Office in respect of fishery management• Liaising with syndicate members• Providing updates on river and fishing conditions• Grounds and property maintenance (potentially)• Briefing the visitors (the successful candidate will receive appropriate training and will be appointed as an approved River Watcher)• Maintaining the fishing huts and WC to a high standard• Undertaking daily visits to the fishery• Responding to reports of potential trespass/poaching
REMUNERATION	A competitive hourly rate of pay will be offered, payable fortnightly in arrears.
HOURS OF WORK (SEASONAL)	The successful applicant will be required to work during the fishing season only and during the shoulder weeks to allow for pre and post season works. During the season the successful candidate will work on average 1 hour per day. If required to guide, it will be necessary to work approximately 8 hours per day.
